

Weld



- All Pro-Vent® fittings supplied with socket ends.
- Wall thickness up to and including 3mm joined by single pass hot air welding using 5mm x 3mm triangle welding rod.
- Wall thickness 5mm and greater requires hot air or extrusion welding.
- Fittings can be tack welded during installation to ensure proper alignment, then hot air welded to seal all joints.
- When fully cooled, Pro-Vent® welds do not require an additional cure time and are ready for service.
